

Opening Our Churches (update 11/21/21)

At the Parish of St. Charles Borromeo, Resurrection, and All Saints the congregation at our Churches are encouraged to return to in-person attendance at Sunday Mass.

Registration for Mass is NO longer required. If you attend Mass in person, you should expect that masks will be required and social distancing in church seating will also be required for everyone except those who choose to sit together. All are encouraged to use the hand sanitizers available when they enter the Church. Temperatures will continue to be taken. Holy Communion will be offered in the hands ONLY. Following each Mass, the congregation should leave the Church immediately so that the sanctuary and body of our churches may be thoroughly cleaned. Bulletins will be distributed after Mass.

At St. Charles Borromeo, the seating capacity in the church EACH SUNDAY will be limited to 150 persons for each Mass. Additional attendees will be asked to view the Mass in the auditorium on a large screen with sound. Holy Communion will be distributed in the auditorium, as well as in the church.

At Resurrection, socially-distanced seating remains in effect EACH SUNDAY. Social distancing in church seating will be required for everyone except those who choose to sit together.

The above protocols will remain in place and will be reviewed periodically. Further adaptations to Church coronavirus practices will be made when necessary or mandated by the CDC and the Archdiocese.

Beginning January 8, 2022, there will be three Masses each Sunday at St. Charles Borromeo in English and two Masses each Sunday at Resurrection, one in Spanish and one in English.
